IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINE

Year 1-2: Research, convene, transmit strategic plan

Year 3: Mayor works with elected officials/authorities for full authority of emerging adults. Hires coordinator to operationalize plan.

Year 4: Multiple pilots implemented. Existing programs expanded through budget and appropriations.

Year 5: Continue programming. Develop evaluations

Year 6+: Continue to innovate and expand efforts. Address and improve other interventions.
